RULES OF THE GAME –
WSOP BONUS TEXAS HOLD’EM POKER –
AMENDMENTS

- The Commission makes the following findings in respect of an application to approve the game and the rules of the game to be known as WSOP Bonus Texas Holdem:
 - a) The Commission approves, under section 60 of the *Casino Control Act* 1991 (‘the Act’), amendments to the approved rules of the approved game of WSOP Bonus Texas Holdem as follows –
 - amendment of the approved rules to allow for the term “single deck card shuffling shoe” to be replaced, wherever it occurs, with “automatic shuffling machine”;
 - amendment of rule 7.3.1 to ensure that a hand held dealing shoe will be used;
 - amendment of the previously numbered rule 7.3.2 which has been deleted; and
 - amendment of the definitions to include a definition of “Automatic Shuffling Machine”.
- Section 60 of the Act requires the Commission to approve the game and rules for the games that are played at the Casino.
- Section 60 (2) (b) of the Act prohibits the conduct of a game in a casino unless the approved rules for the game are published on the casino operator's website and are available for inspection in the casino at the time the game is conducted or played.
- The Commission finds the rules of the game to be compliant with principles of player fairness and game security.

APPROVAL OF TRAINING COURSE **GORDON INSTITUTE OF TAFE**

- Section 9A.1.18 the *Gambling Regulation Act* 2003 ('the Act') enables the Victorian Commission for Gambling Regulation to approve training courses and refresher courses that relate to the responsible provision of gaming. In order for a course to be recognised as meeting the requirement for gaming industry employee training or refresher training the provider must have VCGR approval for the course.
- At its meeting of 22 August 2006, the Commission approved THHADG03B Provide Responsible Gaming Services as a training course that relates to the responsible service of gaming.
- In addition to the learning outcomes of THHADG03B, providers also need to demonstrate to the Commission that the full course they are offering meets the criteria developed by the Responsible Gambling Ministerial Advisory Council (RGMAC) and recommended for inclusion in a full training course.
- The full course materials submitted by Gordon Institute of TAFE have been assessed as including the learning outcomes recommended by the RGMAC.
- At its meeting of 10 June 2008 the Commission approved the responsible provision of gaming training full course offered by Gordon Institute of TAFE with approval to take effect from 10 June 2008 for a period of five years, in accordance with section 9A.1.18(3B) of the Act.

APPROVAL OF REFRESHER TRAINING COURSE
BRACE EDUCATION TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT LTD

- Section 9A.1.18 the *Gambling Regulation Act* 2003 ('the Act') enables the Victorian Commission for Gambling Regulation to approve training courses and refresher courses that relate to the responsible provision of gaming. In order for a course to be recognised as meeting the requirement for gaming industry employee training or refresher training the provider must have VCGR approval for the course.
- At its meeting of 22 August 2006, the Commission approved THHADG03B Provide Responsible Gaming Services as a full training course that relates to the responsible service of gaming.
- In addition to being accredited to provide THHADG03B, providers of refresher courses also need to demonstrate to the Commission that the refresher course they are offering meets the criteria developed by the Responsible Gambling Ministerial Advisory Council (RGMAC) and recommended for inclusion in an update course.
- The refresher course materials submitted by BRACE Education Training and Employment Ltd have been assessed as including the learning outcomes recommended by the RGMAC.
- At its meeting of 10 June 2008 the Commission approved the responsible provision of gaming refresher course offered by BRACE Education Training and Employment Ltd with approval to take effect from 10 June 2008 for a period of five years, in accordance with section 9A.1.18(3B) of the Act.
